GOD OF MERCY

My miracle started back in January 2009; I was involved in an auto accident while pregnant. I had to undergo series of physio therapy and recovered by the grace of God. In March 2009, I started having strange dreams and attacks in my dreams. I prayed constantly for the safety of myself and my baby. By the end of May, I had this particular dream

that was very disturbing and I made a decision not only to pray but to fast as well. I recall my husband’s worries about the idea of fasting while I was 5 months pregnant but I knew that I needed to equip myself spiritually for the battle ahead of me.

I was not feeling well the first weekend in June but I could not really place my finger on what was wrong, all I knew was that I was tired a lot and the more I rested, the more exhausted I became. Then I had a dream on Saturday, June 6, 2009, in the dream, I was preparing for a party and had rented a hall for my party. I even paid the owner of the hall extra money to ensure that minor renovations were carried out in the hall to make it more comfortable and presentable for my guest. On the day of the party, I arrived before my guests to take a look at the venue but was shocked at what I saw. The floor of the hall was cracking, the wall was peeling, the roof had caved in from the top and the ceiling was made with old dirty rags, the rags were all hanging down from the ceiling. Most of the floor was covered in carpet but some areas were covered with the same old rags on the ceiling.

I asked the individual that I had paid previously to carry out the extra renovation why the place was in a mess and he responded that those he trusted to take care of the hall had messed it up for me and that the hall has been deemed inhabitable and unsafe for anyone to enter in. I had no idea what he meant by that but I was in a panic because at that point some of my guests were already arriving. When I looked up though, I observed that the number “5315” was written at the entrance of the hall. I was then approached by my sister who asked me to look to the right of the hall and when I looked there was another hall. She also informed me that the individual was trying to cheat me out of what rightfully belonged to me because the hall that was in a mess was not meant for my party. She then suggested we inspect the other hall to see if it was available. I observed as I entered to inspect the hall that the number “719” was written at the entrance. The hall was not ideal but it was okay for my guest to move in and we proceeded with the party. I then noticed that the hall was also in a hospital. It was on the bottom floor of a high rise hospital. So I moved my guest to hall “719” and we had a really good party.

I shared my dream with my husband when I woke up, though we did not understand the dream, we knew it was serious and we decided

to pray for God's covering and protection. The following day, I continued to feel sick and as I arrived home from attending the Sunday service, I had a strong urge in my spirit to go to the hospital. When I arrived at the emergency, the baby was monitored and I remember the alarmed look on the face of the nurse when she listened for the baby's heart beat. She stated that she was concerned with the baby's breathing and I was asked to return the following morning for further monitoring.

I was exactly 28 weeks pregnant, when I returned to the hospital on the morning of June 8. I was taken in for an ultrasound and it was a very long session. There was a lot poking in the lower part of my abdomen and I kept asking the nurse if all was well. When she eventually concluded the testing, she provided me with the result and to my surprise, she advised to take it immediately to Labour and Delivery. Few minutes after my arrival at labour and delivery, I was approached by a doctor who advised me that I will be delivering my baby in a day or two. I was destruct and confused. He explained that the baby had stopped growing 3 weeks prior and it was in our best interest to deliver her within the next 24 to 48 hours. He also advised that I will be transferred by ambulance to another community hospital as they were not equipped to handle my situation. I arrived at hospital number two approximately 12 noon and I was immediately admitted and placed under further monitoring. As I lay on the bed in the second hospital, I remembered my dream and asked my hubby to find out the number of the room I was occupying. He returned and advised it was room number "5315". I then reminded him of my dream two nights before and at that point, it became clear to us based on my dream that I was going to be moved to another room. After about 8 hours of monitoring, the doctor on duty arrived and informed us that I was going to be transferred to a major hospital in downtown Toronto, as they were not equipped to handle my case. This was now the third hospital transfer in one day.

I was in a panic at this point but confident that God was in control, we prayed for strength before the paramedics took me away. I had small talk with the paramedics as I was being transported to the hospital and asked what floor I was being transported to. When he said the 7th floor, I knew right away that I was going to be in room "719" or would have something to do with "719" when I arrive. I then shared with him that I believe I will be admitted in room "719", he asked if I was a psychic, and when I said no, he looked at me like I was a little weird, so I decided to share my dream.

When we arrived at the hospital at 10:30pm that night, the nurses at the station advised the paramedics to place me in room "719". I knew then that God was indeed in control of my situation and that everything will work out well. Things were happening so fast from this point but I was confident that all will be well. I probably saw over 8 doctors over the next couple of days and I had lots of nurses going and coming. The medical officials ran several tests following my arrival and to their surprise could not come up with any medical reason as to why the baby had stopped growing 3 weeks before. The same week, they conducted two ultrasounds; the first ultrasound confirmed that baby had stopped growing 3 weeks ago and needed more amniotic fluid. I engaged in spiritual warfare at the hospital and two days later, the second ultrasound showed that there was now improvement in the fluid. The only problem is that doctors were becoming more concerned at their inability to get any medical explanation and for this reason they could not provide me with any treatment.

I remember one morning, I was forced to share with my doctor that the problem was not physical but spiritual.

A decision was made to keep me in the hospital and continue monitoring the baby's growth and heart rate. Five days into my stay, one of the test showed that baby's heart beat was irregular. I was rushed to Labour and delivery on June 13, 2009, I was only 28 weeks and 5 days pregnant. My husband and I prayed for



In late 2001, I started feeling pains in my hands and shoulders but ignored it. I was at that time enrolled in an icing class. During classes, I came down with terrible


pains in both my hand and could not move my fingers. I then went to the doctor and he ran some blood test. I went back a week later to find out that I have Rheumatoid Arthritis and was prescribed Vioxx and Naproxin for the pains. I was then referred to a Specialist. The specialist did some more blood test and from the results she told me that I had chronic rheumatoid arthritis.

In the year 2002, it got worse. I had pains in my knees, hips, shoulders, jaws, and fingers. Every day it was in a different part of my body. I would wake up many nights and cry with pain. Sometimes I could not walk, nor even comb my hair, or brush my teeth, or hold a fork to eat. It even affected my jaw where I could not open my mouth to put the food in. I became desperate and whatever anyone told me to use, I tried it. I used all kinds of rubbing ointments, even the one they used on horses. I did acupuncture for several months and drank Chinese herbs. Some days I would take advil together with the other medication because the pain was so severe. I told the doctor that the medication was not helping and she decided to give me something stronger called plaquenil. She explained that by taking this medication, they will be some side effect which would affect my eyes and other organs. This was in July of 2002. During this trying time, the church was praying for me.

The sickness had become so severe, that my two sisters who lived in Florida decided to come and pay me a visit. The night of July 6th, I woke up at 3:00 o'clock in the morning crying with pain. I woke my husband as I would usually do, to ask him to pray for me. That night, even when I breathe, my body ached. He got up, took me in his arms and prayed a very simple prayer of faith and I fell asleep. I woke up the morning and he asked me how I was feeling. I replied, "I feel much better, there is a difference in my body." He then said to me, "After I prayed for you, I had a dream. It's like someone like an angel touched me on my shoulders and said son, God said to tell you that your wife is healed. It is not instantaneous but in the days ahead the sickness will be driven out of her body and she will feel better each day. We went to church on Sunday and he announced that I was healed, but I was still limping around. I took the medication the doctor gave me for one week and then I stopped. As the weeks went by, I progressively started feeling better and I went back to work. My husband advised me to go back to the specialist and inform her that I am healed and I am not taking any medication, but I would like her to do the blood test again to verify my healing. She said to me, if I did not take the medication, I would end up in a wheel chair. She did repeat the test and I went back in October for the results. She flipped through my file, and then said, One in a million cases go in regression, and my blood reading is normal. I said Thank God, I am healed. I have been off all medication since then. It's been seven years now.

God is an awesome God. He said in his word Mark 11:24 "Therefore I say unto you, What thing so ever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. I was desperate and my desire was that God would heal me. He said "The desire to righteous shall be granted." (Proverbs 10:24) I thank God for healing me, He is Jehovah Rapha, The God that heals. I know he can do the same for you.

God's intervention when I arrived at L and D. The doctors and nurses continued to monitor Miracle and I at L and D. Miracle was taken out by Caesarean section at 7:03am on Sunday, June 14. She weighed only 1 pound 13 ounces. I recall my husband became emotional when she was taken out and he left the OR. Miracle was very tiny but I knew that she had come to fulfill her destiny and even the devil cannot this miracle.

She overcame all medical odds when she was at the Neonatal intensive care unit and was able to breathe on her own few days after her birth. I prayed everyday while she was at the hospital for angels in charge of the children ministry in heaven to surround her and minister to her needs.

We celebrated as a family when she reached 2 pounds and every milestone was an opportunity for us to thank God for her life.

We believe that since the devil could not kill her in my womb, it was impossible for anyone to stop her now.

It is important to note that Miracle is not my first child. I had successfully carried pregnancies to term and delivered babies naturally. So this whole experience was totally new to us.

My daily visit to the hospital allowed me to see the pain and despair of many parents. I met women who could not carry babies to term and some of them had buried multiple babies already. I knew then that part of the reason I was in the hospital was for me to share Christ with them. I began praying for mothers and their babies. I made myself available as prayer partners and soon the word got around that there was someone they could talk to or call for prayers. We eventually began having weekly meetings just to pray for our babies. The more I immersed myself in praying for others, the stronger my Miracle became and the less I thought about my problems. God began to move and work wonders and miracles at the hospital and soon there were testimonies regarding what God was doing in our midst.

Miracle was discharged after 8 weeks in the

hospital and she has continued to grow and beat every medical concern that was raised by her doctors. I give God all the glory for his faithfulness to his words. I recall that the bible verse that readily came to us in the midst of our trial was Isaiah 65 VS 20-23. When I look back now, God has been faithful to every word he had spoken in those verses.

I kept confessing while she was at the NICU that the devil had to first kill God and then his son Jesus and the Holy spirit before he could touch the life of my Miracle and since I knew it was impossible for the devil to accomplish that, I pretty much trusted in the Lord and Jesus proved Jehovah Rapha faithful in my case.

I want to encourage you today not to give up in your situation, God will never give up on you so don't give up on yourself. The bible says many are the afflictions of the righteous but the Lord delivers them from it all (Psalm 34:19). In the midst of our trials, we are OVERCOMERS in Jesus' name.

- To keep trusting God for perfection of every good work He Has started in your life even when your physical eyes cannot see the full manifestation.

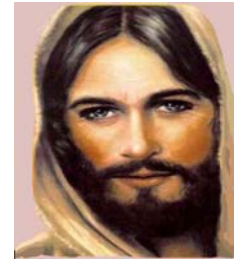

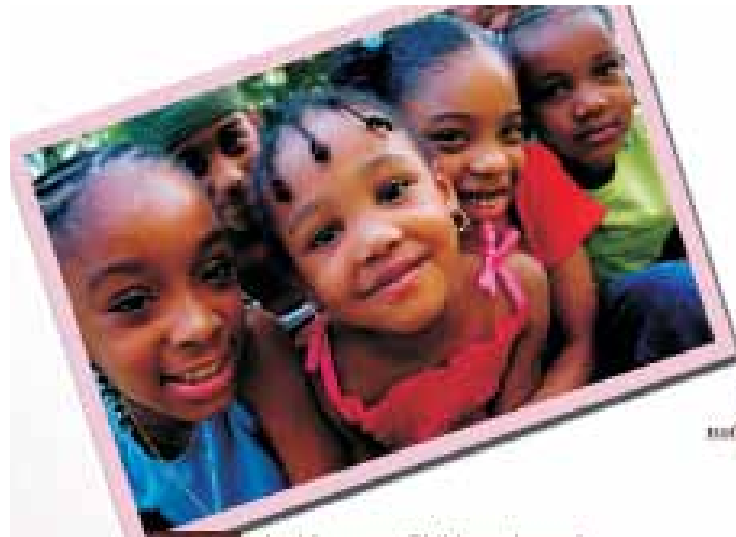

We often wonder if there were three or more of them. Because they brought three gifts, gold (for a king), frankincense (incense to worship God) and myrrh (for burial preparation - Jesus' crucifixion), some say there were three of them but we are not certain of how many they were.

Mathew 2:1 Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, 2 Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? For we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him. 3 When Herod the king had heard these things, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him.... 9 When they had heard the king, they departed; and, lo, the star, which they saw in the east, went before them, till it came and stood over where the young child was. 10 When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy. 11 And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense and myrrh.

The "star" that led the wise men to Jesus Christ in Bethlehem was an extraordinary star. This star "went before them, till it came and stood over where the young Child was" Matthew 2:9. "His star" mentioned in verse 2 could have been an angel. We also know that Jesus is the bright and morning star Revelation 22:16. He would continue to show us the way as we follow Him.

There are some lessons to learn from the story of the wise men;

The moment the wise men diverted into the palace they lost sight of the star and all they saw were the things around them. We must focus on the King of kings, Jesus the author and finisher of our faith. Hebrews 12:2

The question asked by the wise men "Where is he that is born King of the Jews?" led to the death of many innocent children. "Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wrath, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem... .." Mathew 12:16-18. Though these were wise men but in this instance they did not apply godly wisdom from the question

5. Some of these include:

- Joseph was wise and discerning. In Genesis 41:39, Pharaoh declared "...Inasmuch as God has shown you all this, there is no one as wise and discerning as you"

- Joseph lived a life of holiness. When

tempted by Potiphar's wife, he declared emphatically in Genesis 39:9 ".....How then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God"

- Joseph displayed Christ-like love for his brothers who sold him into slavery. With uncanny faith in the overriding providence of God, he even professes his belief that God used his brother's betrayal of him as a means to deliver his family during the time of famine. Genesis 45:7

- Joseph was diligent and hardworking. We can see this in Genesis 39:3 - "And his master saw that the lord was with him and that the lord made all that he did to prosper in his hand"

- Joseph was focused and refused to be distracted by the negative circumstances that he faced. Genesis 39:21

- Joseph used his initiative and was a problem solver. This is evident in Genesis 40:7 - "So he asked pharaoh's officers who were with him in the custody of his lord's house, saying, "Why do you look so sad today?"
